

Cookies policy

Effective as of August 1, 2020

Wallet Factory Pl sp.z o.o ("WFI" "we," "us," "our," or the "Company") a company, established under the laws of Poland address St. Rydygiera 16/1 Wrocław, Poland 50-249.

WFI uses cookies, web beacons and similar technologies to collect and store information about your device, computer and how do visitors use our website. Such information is collected automatically when visiting the website. We use the term "cookies" in this policy to refer to cookies and all other similar technologies.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that sent to the user`s Internet browser and stored on their device. They are designed to improve the functionality and use of the website, also for the purpose of analysis, to streamline the access to the website and information contained therein.

There are four types of cookies that we use on our website:

1. **Strictly necessary cookies.** Some cookies are strictly necessary to navigate the website, response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, for example, setting your privacy preferences and filling in forms, or to use its basic functionality. Without strictly necessary cookies you cannot use the website properly. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of our website will not work then. These cookies do not store any personal data and they are always on.
2. **Functionality cookies.** These cookies are used to remember you when you visit the website again and provide an improved personalized service. For example, the website may ask you for certain information, or remember information about your choice, for example, language or location. These cookies collect information anonymously and cannot track your visits to other websites.
3. **Analytical and operational cookies.** This type of cookies allows you to store information about how you use the website and how many times you visit it. For example, we store information about which pages you visit most often and where you receive error messages. This allows us to improve the operation of the website, including providing quick access to important information that is of interest to you. These cookies serve only to improve the quality of the website.
4. **Target or advertising cookies.** These cookies are created in order to remember the number of visits to the website, as well as a list of pages that you open and links that you click on. These cookies are designed to ensure that you receive only relevant advertising information appropriate to your interests. They serve only to limit the number of impressions shown to you by advertising messages, and also help evaluate the effectiveness of advertising campaigns. We may also transfer this information to third parties (for example, advertisers) for the same purposes.

Here you can find each cookie we use and the reasons for using them.

WFI never allows third parties to collect information using cookies directly on the pages of our website or a mobile application to collect information about how you use the website, in order to optimize your experience as a user, and in order to display advertising outside this website. The data they collect is protected in accordance with Wallet Factory's current privacy policy.

Web beacons.

WFI uses Web beacons alone or in conjunction with cookies to compile information about the usage of the Company's website and interaction with emails from the Company. Web beacons are clear electronic images that can recognize certain types of information on your computer or device, such as cookies, when you viewed a particular website or service tied to the Web beacon, and a description of a website or service tied to the Web beacon. For example, WFI may place Web beacons in marketing emails that notify us when you click on a link in the email that directs you to our website. WFI uses Web beacons to operate and improve our website and email communications.

How to block cookies?

You can choose to block cookies by activating the settings on your browser that allow you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including strictly necessary cookies) you may not be able to access parts of the website. Your browser settings also allow you to delete all cookies stored on your device whenever you wish.

Usually the navigation parameters associated with cookies can be found in the "Options", "Tools" or "Settings" sections of the web browser which you use to access the website.

However, depending on the browser you use, various methods can be used to disable cookies. For more information, see the following links:

The mobile application mWallet

Our mobile application mWallet does not use cookies.

The application uses local storage (localStorage). Unlike cookies, which can be accessed both on the server and on the user's part, localStorage underlies exclusively under the competence

of scripts (scripts) on the user`s part. LocalStorage data is not transmitted to the server with every HTTP request, and the web server cannot directly write to localStorage, which makes it more reliable from interception.
